IN-SCHOOL PROGRAMMING

Art with a Heart is available to provide a part-time or full-time in-school visual arts program. Art with a Heart's contracted teaching staff provide a consistent and caring presence for students and seamlessly integrate into the school community, providing a high quality and equitable visual arts program.

OUT-OF-SCHOOL TIME (OST) PROGRAMMING

Art with a Heart can provide classes for on-going programs or one-time community events. Each program is designed specifically to meet the needs of the partner organization, whether it be for adults, early childhood development, families, seniors, or other more. Each program is continuously refined based on student and teacher feedback after every class.

Below are a sample of program offerings that can be tailored to meet your program needs:

ARTS INTEGRATED

Students create artwork based on in-school curricula provided by teachers. The goal is to create a hands-on art experience to enhance, solidify and animate the learning process. Content areas include, but are not limited to: math, science, history, literacy, and wellness. All programming is skill and curriculum based and can be custom designed to meet the specific needs of students or subjects matter selected.

CERAMICS

Students learn about techniques, materials, and tools used in ceramic art making. Through revising, refining and reflecting, each student will bring their design to fruition through an understanding of the entire ceramics process.

ARTS AROUND THE WORLD

Students take a trip around the world by learning about various cultures and their renowned and indigenous art! These hands-on visual art classes allow students to explore the people, places, customs, ideas, artists and artwork of countries all over the world.



FULL S.T.E.A.M AHEAD

Students are immersed in a hands-on art curriculum based on STEM subjects with an emphasis on using the Engineering Design Process to guide student inquiry, dialogue, and critical thinking. Projects introduce inspire students to take thoughtful risks, engage in experiential learning, persist in problem-solving, embrace collaboration, and work through the creative process.

THE ART OF READING

Students discover classic and new children's books through this artful reading adventure. Each session will begin with reading a children's book aloud and students will respond through art with curriculum concepts including the book themes & illustrations.

COMMUNITY ART

Community art is an excellent way to teach and emphasize teamwork. Students work together to create a specially designed art installation for the school while using a variety of materials and techniques. The resulting artwork may integrate school colors, values and themes that will certainly beautify your learning environment, either inside or out.

LEADERSHIP THROUGH ART

Bridging concrete concepts and creativity, students learn leadership skills and ideas through the art-making process. Example concepts covered include what it means to be visionary, and how to become strategic, focused, and ethical. Students also learn about significant people who have worked towards promoting community service and active citizenship.

CREATIVE CONVERSATIONS

This curriculum uses learning communities as a strategy to discuss the way art intersects around community engagement, civic action and social justice. Students examine relevant social justice themes and engage in discussions to examine an equitable society where more people are educated, involved and working together toward the highest ideals of democracy, community, safety and security for all. Students will create artwork representative of the collective creative thinking of the group of individuals who come together across life experiences to envision a new and more peaceful society.

ARTS AND TECHNOLOGY

Art with a Heart is prepared to implement the Maker's Foundation curriculum with your students. This program is designed to introduce students to a variety of technology topics to help them better understand some of the newest digital technologies available. This weekly course is divided into 10 modules focused on web development, game development, 3D Design & Printing, graphic design, digital communication, and electronics. These modules can be implemented during daytime or after school programs and take between 1 to 4 sessions to cover completely depending on the number of hours. Art with a Heart will provide the computers, software, instructors and all necessary materials.



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
